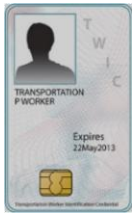
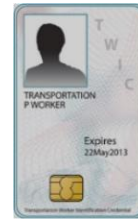


# TWIC – Transportation Worker Identification Credential



# TWIC



## Security - Access - Privacy

The Transportation Worker Identification Credential, also known as TWIC is required by the Maritime Transportation Security Act for workers who access maritime facilities and vessels. Transportation Security Administration (TSA) conducts a background check to determine a person's eligibility and issues the credential in the form of a card that is carried with you.

- **TWIC is required for unescorted access to the terminal and must be shown to and verified by security to gain entrance onto the terminal.**
- **If an individual does not have a TWIC card, an \$80 escort fee (per person) will be assessed, credit card payment is required (cash not accepted).**
- **TWIC must be valid and not expired.**
- **All intermodal / container drivers are REQUIRED to have a valid TWIC.**
